(1) A Call From the Wild & A Call to the Mild - Doug Bolan

This workshop will seek to enlighten you on the awesome benefits of getting out in God's creation, His wild landscape for the sole purpose of obtaining rest and solitude within His presence (where He can speak to your heart).

(2) Asian American Ministries in New York City- Howard Chan

The Asian American church in New York City has been around for more than 60 years and yet you "could almost count on one hand" the number of Asian American "English Ministry congregations" that exist in NYC today. Why is that so? Is the Asian American church in New York City destined to remain small and inconsequential? Or can something be done that will enable God to transform the landscape of Asian American ministries?

(3) Reaching the Unreached: The Unique Role of Asian Americans in Missions - Elyse Lee

Have you ever considered your design in the Body of Christ as an Asian-American? Have you ever thought about your unique role as the children or grandchildren of immigrants- possibly the first generation to be born and raised in an Asian church in the United States? This workshop will look at the Biblical basis of missions from Genesis to Revelations, and the culturally specific bridges and barriers of the call to mission in our lives as Asian Americans.

(4) Beyond Boundaries: Working Out a Biblical View of Sex and Relationships - Peter Ong

This two part workshop is for those seeking to understand how we are to navigate our way through the complex issue of engaging our faith with the overwhelming culture where mainstream culture calls us to a lifestyle like "Sex & the City." The second part of the workshop will challenge us to have a new way of looking of how relationships could look like in and out of church.

(5) Weight Management: A Spiritual Battle - Jonely Moy

All our issues and problems are spiritual battles—including weight loss! Victory can be yours by dealing with them all as spiritual warfare. While not entirely about weight loss, weight management will be used as one example of how our "mundane" issues, and problems, are really spiritual battles preventing us from attaining God's Promises.

(6) Forgiveness - Kelly Ng

Forgiveness is absolutely needed in a fallen world where bad things happen to all of us. Pain, disappointment, betrayal, heartbreak, intentional and unintentional wounding...the list goes on. Painful events in life can either take us captive or be a seed to life-giving growth and freedom. The difference can be true forgiveness. In this workshop, we dispel myths about forgiveness that prevent healing and look at what true Biblical forgiveness is. True forgiveness powerfully sets us free and glorifies God.

(7) Rest In Service - Janas Caruncho

Have you wrestled with trying to find rest in this busy world we live in? Have you ever been burnt-out while trying to serve God? Have you ever been frustrated with the people you are trying to care for? In this workshop, we will explore Jesus' offer of rest for those who are weary and burdened, and discover anew the rest that Jesus calls us to. What does it look like to have rest in service? Christian rest is not laziness, but a proper view or servant hood.
